### 1. Just in Time, Abraham Lincoln

All students are required to read and complete a book report about the book, **Just in Time, Abraham Lincoln** by Patricia Polacco.

Each report should include:

- A. Cover Page - The cover page should be an illustration of your favorite part of the book. Take your time, be creative & make sure your work is neat and clean. You will need to include:
  - a. Title of the book
  - b. Author's name
  - c. Your name
- B. Report –
  - a) Paragraph One – Using 5-7 sentences, write a summary of **Just in Time, Abraham Lincoln**. Be certain to include information on the setting, main characters and plot.
  - b) Paragraph Two – Using 7-10 sentences, give your opinion of the book. Did you enjoy reading this book? Would you recommend it to a friend? Be sure to support your opinion by telling me why or why not!
