Cost/Paperwork Requirements:

- All families must be current on tuition payments at LHS in order to register for camps.
- **CURRENTLY ENROLLED LHS Families**
 - Turn in your completed registration via delivery to the front office OR upload to <https://bit.ly/3J9lcge>
 - You will be billed for this summer camp through your school FACTS account
 - We should already have your birth certificate and immunization records on file
- **NEW Campers (not enrolled for 21-22 or 22-23 school year at LHS)**
 - Turn in your completed registration to the main office OR upload to <https://bit.ly/3J9lcge>
 - A check made out to "LHS" or cash must be included with your registration form in order to be added to the camp rosters.
 - Campers may not attend camp without all of the below completed and turned in (*camp fees are nonrefundable if a child is not able to attend camp due to incomplete forms*):
 - Summer Camp Registration Form needs to be fully completed along with camp fee payment
 - The office will need to see your child's birth certificate
 - A fully completed Virginia Health Form (*click [HERE](#) for Health Form*)- **completed by parent and physician**
- Camp fees cannot be refunded. Students who miss camp due to an illness will be sent home craft supplies and materials from the camp.
- **Extended Day from 7-9am and 1:30-3:00 is available upon request: (\$8.50/hr or any part of an hour)**
- **All School Safety and Health Policies from the 2021-2022 school year will continue to be in effect. Please know that by registering for LHS Summer Camps that all families are expected to follow these Health and Safety Policies (see the end of the camp registration to review the policies).**
- **Kids bring snack daily (labeled with name and date); bring lunch daily (labeled with name and date); bring water bottle (labeled with name and date); wear sunscreen and bug spray (we can't apply sunscreen or bug spray to your child so you must apply it prior to the start of the day)**

LHS Health Guidelines

Mask wearing is parent/family choice at LHS.

It is imperative that families keep children home who are not feeling well. We trust and know that you will do your part to keep our school safe and open. DO NOT send your child to school if they are experiencing any symptoms of illness, including mild symptoms.

Symptoms for Covid-19 mimic influenzas, colds, and allergies. They include but are not limited to: cough, sore throat, headache, congestion or runny nose, fever and/or chills, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, loss of taste or smell, nausea and/or vomiting, diarrhea.

If your child is experiencing any of the symptoms listed above, please keep them home with the following guidelines:

- For 72 hours symptom free
- For 48 symptom free and a doctor's note saying they are cleared to return to school
- We encourage families to have students with COVID-19 symptoms tested.
- We ask parents to notify the School if their child or anyone in the family has tested positive for Covid-19 or been exposed to someone who has tested positive.

Linton Hall School COVID-19 Health & Safety Guidelines for Staff & Students:

If someone in your household tests positive or you've had a close contact with someone who tested positive for COVID-19:

Vaccinated students and anyone who has tested positive for COVID in the past 90 days, do not need to quarantine but need to monitor for symptoms and wear a well fitted mask for 10 days after exposure. **this is subject to change based on class sizes and spaces and age groups*

Unvaccinated students must stay home for 5 days (10 days for our 2 and 3 year olds)

Students may return after day 5 (from their last exposure) as long as they are symptom free and have had a negative test, a negative lab reported antigen test, or two negative antigen home tests 48 hours apart taken after day 5.

Both vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals exposed to Covid-19 must wear a well fitted mask for 5 days after exposure in all public settings. If you do not want your child to wear a mask for the last 5 days, students can just complete the 10 day quarantine at home.

If a student or staff member test positive for COVID-19

Students or staff members who test positive for Covid-19, regardless of their vaccination status will stay home for 10 days, **OR PLEASE call school to discuss if your student is eligible to return after 5 days.**

In K-8, close contacts will be notified as best as possible and will follow the above guidelines for close contacts.

In preschool, the affected class will be quarantined for the recommended 10 days (with the following exceptions: those who have had COVID-19 in the past 90 days or those who are vaccinated **this is subject to change based on class sizes and spaces and age groups.*)

At any point in time, the school may ask for a student to have a negative COVID test result or doctor's note stating it is safe for the student/staff member to return to school.
