Camps are open to a variety of ages from preschool – 8th grade. Linton Hall School students, siblings, & friends are welcome!

Summer Camp Details

Registration Deadline:

- Please return your completed registration as soon as possible so we can begin planning and purchasing materials. Classes are filled on a first-come, first-served basis according to the date a *complete* registration packet is received (completed registration form, full payment including supply fees, and all required supporting documents).

Cost and Paperwork Requirements:

Currently Enrolled LHS Families:

- All Linton Hall School families must be current on tuition payments to register for camps.

- Children must be fully potty trained for half and full day camps
- **Billing:** Summer camp fees will be billed through your school **FACTS** account. *If you register within two weeks of a camp start date, payment must be made by check or cash at the time of registration to secure your child's spot.*
- **Records on File:** We should already have your child's **birth certificate and immunization records** on file.
- **Newly enrolled families:** will need to submit their child's birth certificate and immunization records.

New Campers (not enrolled for 25-26 school year at LHS):

- Once your camp registration has been processed, you will receive a confirmation email with the total amount due for your selected camps. Camp fees may be paid by cash or check made payable to "LHS." Please note that camp fees must be paid within **two weeks of the date of the confirmation email** in order to secure your child's spot in the camp.
- **Campers may not attend camp unless all of the items listed below are fully completed and submitted.** *Please note: camp fees are nonrefundable if a child is unable to attend camp due to incomplete or missing forms*
 1. Summer Camp Registration form
 2. A copy of your child's birth certificate must be on file with the office
 3. A fully completed Virginia Health Form (completed by both parent and physician) must be submitted ([Click here for a copy of the VA Health Form](#))
 4. Camp fee payment must be received
 5. Children must be fully potty-trained for half and full day camps

Reimbursement:

- Camp fees may be refunded minus a \$75 deposit up to three weeks prior to the start of camp. Refunds will not be issued within three weeks of the camp start date. If a camp is canceled due to low enrollment, families will be offered an alternative camp or receive a full refund of camp fees. **Supply fees are non-refundable.** Students who miss camp due to illness or any other reason will receive their camp craft supplies and materials to take home; however, no refunds will be issued.

Extended Care:

- Extended Care is available from 1:00–4:00 pm on most camp weeks and is offered with limited availability. The rate is \$10.00 per hour (or any portion of an hour). Preregistration is required; drop-ins are not permitted. Billing is processed weekly.
- When a family registers for extended care for a specific week, they are registering for **the entire week**.
- A minimum of **5 children** must be enrolled in Summer Extended Care in order to operate extended care hours from 1:00–4:00 pm.
- If a family registers for extended care but does not utilize the program during that week, a **\$20.00 "no-show" fee** will be charged, as staffing is scheduled based on preregistration.

- Pick-up after **4:00 pm** will result in a **\$25.00 late fee** for each occurrence.

Health & Safety

- All School Health and Safety Policies from the 2025–2026 school year will remain in effect. By registering for LHS Summer Camps, families agree to follow the school’s Health and Safety Policies. These policies are included at the end of the camp registration form for review.

What campers need to bring:

- **Daily Items:** Please send a **snack, lunch, and water bottle** each day. All items must be **labeled with your child’s name and the daily date**.
- **Sunscreen & Bug Spray:** Please apply **sunscreen and bug spray** to your child **before arriving at camp**, as staff are unable to apply these items during the day.

Growing Together Parent and Child Classes:

“**Little Sprouts Growing Together**” **parent and child classes for 2 and 3 year olds** (**COST:** \$100 for all 4 sessions or \$30 per class. No discount for multiple camps, max 8 campers). **Dates Mondays, June 15, 22, 29 and July 6th and time: 9:45-10:45 am**

- Instructors:** Kristy Hosein
- Description:** This is a 4-week, **one-hour parent-child class held on Mondays**, designed to encourage basic developmental skills in toddlers and to ease the transition to school for children attending Little Sprouts for the first time in the fall. Each class includes activities that support fine and gross motor development as well as social skills. Children and caregivers will enjoy songs, movement, crafts, stories, and more. A parent or other adult accompanies the child for the duration of each class.

LHS Health Guidelines:

Linton Hall School Health Guidelines It is imperative that families keep children home who are not feeling well. We trust and know that you will do your part to keep our school safe and open. DO NOT send your child to school if they are experiencing any symptoms of illness, including mild symptoms.

Please keep your child at home if they have symptoms of illness including: cough, sore throat, headache, congestion or runny nose, fever and/or chills, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, loss of taste or smell, nausea and/or vomiting, diarrhea, rash of unknown origin especially if accompanied by and/or following a fever, eye redness with discharge.

If your child is experiencing any of the symptoms listed above, please keep them home with the following guidelines:

- For 24 hours symptom free (children should be eating, drinking, and sleeping well and fever/diarrhea/vomiting free without medications for a full 24 hours and any lingering coughing should be infrequent and mild). If your child returns to school after the 24 hour symptom free period but is not acting like themselves (fatigued, not participating in classroom activities, etc.), then we will notify parents for an early pick up to err on the side of caution.
- We encourage families to have students with respiratory illness symptoms tested (for flu, RSV, COVID-19, etc.)
- If you have a K-8 student, we ask you to notify the school nurse by email at evail@lintonhall.edu or call at 571-428-2557 if your child has tested positive for a respiratory illness (flu, RSV, COVID-19, etc.). All medical information is kept confidential.
- If you have a Little Sprouts student, we ask you to notify Little Sprouts by email at littlesprouts@lintonhall.edu or call at 571-428-2565 if your child has tested positive for a respiratory illness (flu, RSV, COVID-19, etc.). All medical information is kept confidential. We also ask parents to notify the school if your child is positive for any other contagious illness such as strep throat, conjunctivitis (pink eye), norovirus, other gastrointestinal disease, etc. All medical information is kept confidential.

Linton Hall School Respiratory Disease & Safety Guidelines for Staff & Students:

Linton Hall School follows the Virginia Department of Health’s guidelines for preventing the spread of respiratory diseases in our school setting. Please keep your child home if your child has any symptoms of a respiratory virus such as COVID-19, influenza (flu), respiratory syncytial virus (RSV), or a cold. Symptoms of respiratory viruses may include fever, chills, fatigue, cough, runny nose, sneezing, headache, body aches, sore throat, etc.

Linton Hall School will continue to monitor any community spread and reserves the right to amend school health policies based on the guidelines and policies of the Virginia Department of Health. We will notify families of any changes to our school policy should they be deemed necessary at any point. If there are any positive cases for a vaccine preventable illness (including but not limited to chickenpox, measles, mumps, rubella, pertussis, etc.), Linton Hall School will follow the Virginia Department of Health’s (VDH) guidelines for excluding students from school and students will be allowed to return at the discretion of the VDH.
