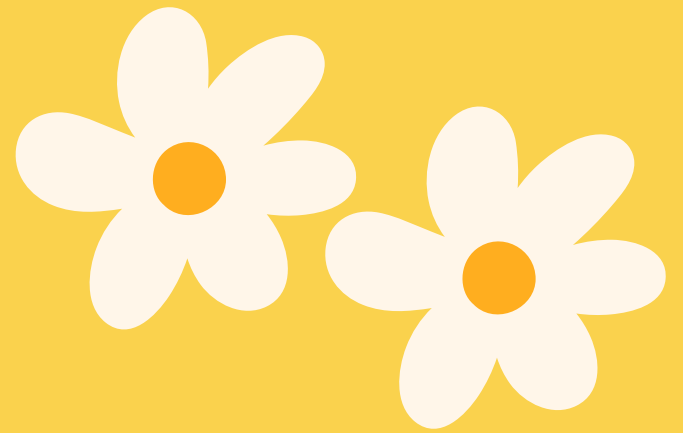


Casey Hawkins
