

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Is Linton Hall School a faith-based school?

- Linton Hall School is a Catholic school for boys and girls in Preschool through Grade 8.
- We are a ministry of the Benedictine Sisters of Virginia.
- Linton Hall School welcomes all faiths.

How many students attend Linton Hall School?

- There are currently 124 students in our Little Sprouts Preschool program. The Preschool includes two 2 Day classes, three 3 Day classes, two PreK classes, and two PreK Bridge classes. Preschool ages range from 2 year olds to 6 year olds.
- There are currently 171 students in our K-8 program. There is one class of each grade for Kindergarten through 8th Grade, and the class sizes are limited to 22 students per class.

What is the teacher to student ratio at Linton Hall School?

- In Preschool, the teacher to student ratio is 1:7, with a teacher and assistant in each classroom.
- The teacher to student ratio in our K-8 program is 1:7 and includes teacher assistants in Kindergarten through grade 2.

Do the students wear uniforms?

- Our Preschool children do not wear a uniform, but do have special Spirit Wear Days each month.
- Students in Kindergarten through 8th Grade are required to wear a uniform.

What are the school hours for Linton Hall School?

- The Preschool hours are 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.; students in our PreK Bridge program dismiss at 1:45 p.m.
- 8:15 a.m. to 3:15 p.m. are the hours for Kindergarten through Grade 8.

Do we offer Before Care and After Care?

- Before Care begins at 7:00 a.m.
- After Care is available until 6:00 p.m.

Is Linton Hall School accredited?

- Yes, Linton Hall School maintains Virginia Association of Independent Schools accreditation.
- In addition, our Preschool is fully licensed through Virginia Department of Social Services.

Is a hot lunch available?

- Our Preschool students pack a lunch from home, and eat in their classrooms.
- We have a daily hot lunch available to purchase for Kindergarten through 8th Grade students.

What types of extracurricular activities are available for my child?

- Preschool students may participate in after school enrichment classes such as cooking, dance, Lego club, Superhero University, and tumbling. Holiday camps for spring and Christmas Breaks are offered as well as summer camp selections. The Preschool also offers Growing Together (Parent & Child) classes to the community.
- Activities available for K-8 students include LHS Fife & Drum Corps, Running Club, Choir, Robotics/Computer Club, Leo service club, 4-H club and school sports. Specific ages and fees may apply. Some activities may be seasonal.

What opportunities are available for parent involvement?

- We have opportunities for everyone. Our Parent School Guild is a fantastic organization that is always encouraging parents to volunteer their time and talents. They are responsible for community building events such as Back to School and End of School family picnics, Community Fun Fair, Winter Bingo Bash, and Teacher Appreciation.
- Classroom parent volunteers are also a great way to be involved here at Linton Hall School.
- There are event committees throughout the year from which to choose.
