Perrino Family Single Parent Scholarship Fund Application Process

Fund Background: Established by Sandy Perrino, a 1948 graduate of Linton Hall School, the Perrino Family Single Parent Scholarship Fund provides tuition assistance to support single parent families who seek a Linton Hall education for their children.

Eligibility Criteria

Families may apply for the Perrino Family Single Parent Scholarship Fund if they:

- Are headed by a single parent (due to divorce, separation, widowhood, or other circumstances)
 - Have a child applying to or currently enrolled at Linton Hall School
 - Demonstrate financial need
 - Are committed to the values, expectations, and community life of Linton Hall School

Application Timeline

- Application Opens: during Open Enrollment time each year (beginning in January)
 - Deadline for Submission: February 15, 2026
 - Notification of Awards: recipients will be notified no later than March 1st

Required Application Materials

- A complete application to Linton Hall School
 - A complete application for financial assistance through www.factstuitionaid.com
 - A personal statement/narrative describing your family situation, financial need, and how the scholarship would support your child's education and help your family
 - All materials should be submitted to the Director of Admissions to forward to the Tuition Assistance Committee

Scholarship awards: are applied directly toward tuition, may cover partial tuition assistance, and are granted on an annual basis and must be reapplied for each year. The award amount may vary year to year based on financial circumstances, continued enrollment, and fund availability. To accept the award, once notified, the family must sign and return the enrollment contract, agree to tuition payment terms, and maintain compliance with school policies. Recipients are expected to maintain good standing with the school, communicate any significant financial changes, and reapply annually if continued assistance is needed.
